Marvin 'Buck' Barrow

Buck is Clyde's older brother, and he idolises his sibling's confidence and devil-may-care attitude. Buck is also an outlaw troubled by his wife's distaste for his lifestyle. He is adventurous and loyal. Buck is killed in a shootout with authorities.

Auditionees for Buck will need to master Buck's conflict for his love of both his brother and wife who both try to control his decisions.
